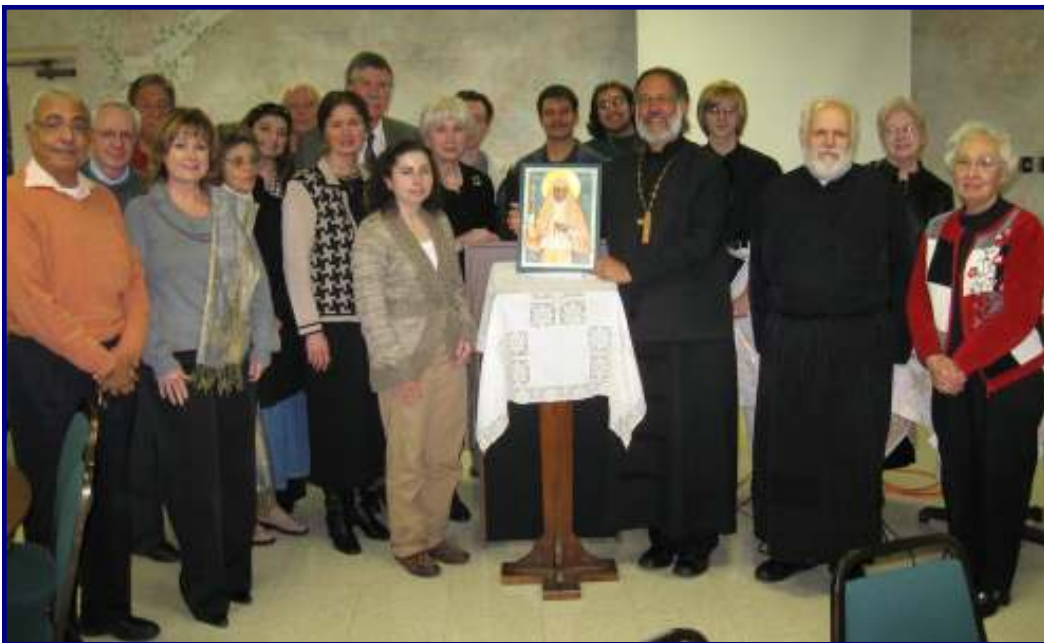




SAINT ELIZABETH HOUSE MISSION TEAM

Dr. Daniel's two presentations focused upon:
